## About the Cover

Leelanau County photographic genius Ken Scott got down for this shot — literally. Taken off Peterson Park in Leelanau Township, the photo perfectly captures what Richard Cookman of Suttons Bay says must be “a ‘great libation amorphous substance stone’ with a rather interesting acronym: GLASS.”

Cookman and his wife, Pat, own Enerdyne in Suttons Bay, a place kids seem to love. It’s a store with much to do about astronomy, birds, and many other things based on science, including rock collecting.

At one time before Lake Michigan had its way with it, Cookman speculated, this crown jewel of Peterson Park might have been a part of a wine bottle. He said some people even “cheat” to make beach glass, dropping them in tumblers. They often are turned into jewelry.

We also contacted Rae Welch Johnson, who creates beautiful jewelry at Case-Daniels & Rae in Suttons Bay. She verified the Beach Glass shown in the picture.

“I discovered my first piece in 1978, and have been mesmerized by it ever since,” she replied. “I didn’t know what it was, but I loved how the light played inside every piece. My fascination for it never ceased, and every chance I had, I collected more...I’ve been seriously making jewelry with it for about 17 years.”

While the green gem shown stands out from a backdrop of granite, basalt and limestone rocks, it does appear a little too glitzy. Wine can have that effect.
